Scholarship Program

Two \$500 Scholarships Available

For Students Pursuing Studies in Forestry, Forest Products Manufacturing, Natural Resources or Environmental Sciences

If you are pursuing studies in Forestry, Forest Products Manufacturing, Natural Resources or Environmental Sciences - you may be eligible for a scholarship from the Lesser Slave Forest Education Society! Residents of Slave Lake, High Prairie, Wabasca and surrounding communities are encouraged to apply.

Two scholarships of \$500 each are available for the 2017-18 academic year. The fields of study that will receive *priority* under the program are:

- Certificate, Diploma, or Degree Programs in Forestry, Natural Resource Management, or Environmental Sciences;
- Certificate or Degree programs in Wood Products Manufacturing;
- Certificate, Diploma, or Degree Programs in Technical Fields leading to a career in the forest products industry.

Opportunity for Additional Student Funding:

The Lesser Slave Forest Education Society is a partner with the Bursary Partnerships Programs of the Northern Alberta Development Council (NADC). As such, students may be eligible to receive a matching \$500 from the NADC. **This would double the award to \$1,000!** More information on this opportunity can be obtained in the attached application form or by visiting www.nadc.ca
